Church Hill Downs' twinspires.com website was built using Drupal 6 and was not able to maintain uptime throughout the most important weekend of the horse racing industry's most famous race, The Kentucky Derby. The site crashed consistently each year during the weekend events leading up to the race.

The solution was to migrate the site to Drupal 7 while providing Site Administrators with Marketing Tools and custom content to help promote the site's activities while maintaining 99% uptime during the Kentucky Derby weekend. In 2012 the site was converted to Drupal 7 and since then each year the site's performance maintained 99% uptime and provided an increase in profits for Church Hill Downs.

As the Senior Developer on the project I was responsible for providing architecture, module development, theme development, and data migration.
